RESOLUTION NO. 10-144 of 2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NORRISTOWN CREATING A CONSOLIDATED
FEE SCHEDULE ASSOCIATED WITH SERVICES, LICENSES, PERMITS AND OTHER
MUNICIPAL ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Norristown has not updated its fee structure for many years; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council intends to update its fee structure and consolidate previously established fees into one document; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Norristown wishes to amend Resolution 07-157, 08-103 and 08-126, 08-139, 08-142, 08-148, 09-107, 09-128, 09-141, 09-147, 09-149, 09-162, 09-176, 10-111, 10-125 and 10-130.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Norristown Municipal Council hereby establishes the following schedule of fees and deposits to be paid to the Municipality.

Maximum fee for private towing company storage for the first 24-hour period from the time the wrecker arrives at the scene: No charge for the first four hours after the tow vehicle arrives at the scene if the vehicle is properly retrieved within that time frame during regular business hours of the tow operator. In the event a tow operator is not open to the public during the time a vehicle is towed, then the four hour grace period starts at the regular opening time of the operator on the next business day. Thereafter storage fees will be a maximum of \$25.00 per day

VI. Code Enforcement, Building and Zoning

1. Contractor's Licenses

Note that all plumbing and electrical employees on the job must be licensed.

Contractor's licenses are valid for the calendar year: January 1 through December 31. Any contractor commencing work without first obtaining a license shall be subject to a payment of double the fee described above.

2. Building Permit Fees

Applicants for permits shall pay a fee based on the total estimated cost of the project (\$70 minimum). The Code Enforcement Department may require the applicant to provide a

contract or other similar documentation to verify estimated project costs. Fees shall be paid at the time the permit is issued.

Residential:	3% up to \$50,000 1.5% above \$50,000 Plus \$4.00 for state charges and \$25 Administrative Fee
Commercial:	3% up to \$50,000 1.5% above \$50,000 Plus \$4.00 for state charges and \$25 Administrative Fee
Mechanical/Electrical/Plumbing	3% of project cost Plus \$4.00 for state charges and \$25.00 Administrative Fee
Fire Alarm and Suppression:	3% of project cost Plus \$4.00 for state charges and \$25.00 Administrative Fee for Fire Alarms; and 3% of project cost Plus \$4.00 for state charges and \$25.-- Administrative fee for Suppression

Any person commencing work without first obtaining an approved permit from the Municipality shall be subject to a payment of double the permit fee described above.

Building permit fees include the cost of two inspections for each phase of the project, e.g., footings, framing, plumbing, etc. Additional inspections, required because of the failure of the work to pass the initial two inspections, shall result in an additional \$30 for each additional inspection.

Inspections canceled by the contractor or resident with less than 24 hours notice shall result in a \$25 cancellation fee.

3. Plan Review Fees

Building plans submitted for review to the Norristown Code Enforcement Department as part of a permit application will be charged an additional fee which shall be paid at the time the permit is issued.

i. Residential Plans	\$70 per hour

A plan review must be completed for ALL fire detection and suppression systems. The

Municipality shall, at its sole discretion, determine when plan reviews for other projects are required.

4. Use and Occupancy Permits

All property that transfers ownership in the Municipality of Norristown must be inspected PRIOR to the settlement and a Use and Occupancy Permit must be issued. Failure to obtain a Use and Occupancy Permit or a Temporary Use and Occupancy Permit prior to settlement will result in double the usual fee. In addition, a U&O inspection and permit is required whenever a property changes use, as determined by either the zoning or building codes.

The property owner may be charged an additional fee for the cost of third-party inspectors, engineers or other professionals needed to complete the inspection, reinspection or plan review.

Use and Occupancy Permit fees must be paid at the time of application. Use and Occupancy Permit fees include the cost of two inspections. Additional inspections, required because of the failure of the work to pass the initial two inspections, shall result in an additional \$30 for each additional inspection.

5. Sign and Banner Permits/Licenses

Property owners wishing to erect a sign must first obtain an approved sign permit:

Any person commencing work without first obtaining an approved sign permit from the Municipality shall be subject to a payment of double the permit fee described above.

Owners of property on which a sign is erected shall pay to the Municipality an annual license fee:

Signs in excess of 20 square feet	\$1.50/Square foot
Signs less than 20 square feet	\$15.00 flat fee
Norristown Volunteer Fire Companies	\$0

Banner Permit Fee \$3.00 per square foot each calendar month the banner is displayed.

6. Rental Licenses

Owners of residential rental property must obtain a license to operate by November 15 of each year, which shall apply to the following year.

- i. \$65 for each rental unit (owner-occupied units are not included) by November 15 of each year.
- ii. \$60 penalty for failure to obtain a license by January 31 of the following year.

Owners of residential rental property who are discovered to be operating a rental unit without a valid license shall be charged double the usual rental fee in addition to any penalties.

Additional rental inspections, required because of the failure to pass the initial inspection and reinspection, shall result in an additional \$30 for each additional inspection.

Inspections cancelled by the landlord with less than 24 hours notice shall result in a \$25 cancellation fee per rental unit which would have been inspected but for the cancellation.

7. Property Abatement

In cases where the Municipality must use its own forces to abate property maintenance violations, property owners will be charged the costs of this service based on the following schedule:

8. Board Up Permit

Owners of property who voluntarily or are ordered to board three or more windows, doors or other openings shall pay a \$100.00 permit fee.

9. Deed Registry Fee

\$10.00 per registry

10. Code Appeals Board

Property owners who wish to appeal a decision of the Code Enforcement Department may do so to the Code Appeals Board. The following expenses are charged to the appellant in order to cover the cost of holding the hearing.

VII. Zoning and Land Development

1. Zoning Permit Fees

Whenever the use or occupancy of a property in Norristown changes, the owner or tenant must obtain a zoning permit prior to occupying the space. Fees cover the cost of review by the zoning officer.

i. Single family residence	\$ 5.00
ii. Multi-Family residential	\$15.00
iii. Commercial	\$20.00

Once the zoning review is complete, a U&O inspection must be completed and a use and occupancy permit issued (see use and occupancy permit above).

2. Zoning Hearing Board Fees

Zoning applicants whose use for a building or other space is denied by the Municipal zoning officer may appeal the zoning hearing board. A fee is charged to cover administrative costs, transcription, legal and other costs associated with the hearing.

3. Subdivision and Land Development

Whenever a parcel of land is divided into two or more lots, or when two or more lots are combined, the property owner must develop a plan and have it reviewed and approved by the Norristown Planning Commission. In addition, whenever a new building or addition is

to be constructed, plans for these improvements must also come before the Norristown Planning Commission. There are two categories of charges: Administrative fees and Escrow Deposits. Administrative fees cover the cost of the application review and administration by Planning Department staff. Administrative fees are not refundable. Escrow deposits are intended to cover the cost of professional services the Planning Commission requires to properly review the application. This includes engineering fees and legal fees. Unused escrow funds are returned to the applicant. If the funds escrowed are insufficient to cover expenses, the Municipality reserves the right to require the applicant to provide an additional escrow deposit. For example, if additional engineering reviews are required because applicant plan submissions were deficient, the Municipality may require additional escrow funds.

IX. Public Works Department

The Public Works Department regulates activities of contractors, utilities and private citizens entering the public right-of-way and streets for certain purposes, particularly construction activity that involves disturbing streets and sidewalks. A permit is required for most activities.

1. Street Openings \$150.00

This includes any public street, avenue, road, lane court cul-de-sac, square, alley, highway or other public place located in the Municipality of Norristown and either for or intended for public use, and shall include the cartway, sidewalk, gutter and right-of-way area.

2. Test Holes

\$50 application fee; \$10 each hole.

3. Utility Poles

\$50 application fee; \$5 each pole

- i. For each 25 lineal feet (parallel to the property line) or fraction thereof: \$50.00
- ii. Each additional 25 lineal feet or fraction thereof: \$20

6. Remove, Trim or Plant Trees

8. Protective Fence, Shed or Office Trailer in the Right-of-Way.

X. Parks and Recreation

- 1. Summer Playground Program - \$100.00 per child

- 2. Park Permits

A permit is required for the use of Municipal Parks for organized events. A fee shall be charged for the use of Elmwood Park, Simmons Park and MLK Park based on the size of the group:

- i. 20 – 50 persons - \$50.00/day
- ii. 51 – 100 persons - \$100.00/day
- iii. 101 to 200 persons - \$200.00/day
- iv. over 200 persons - \$300.00/day

Half of the permit fee will be refunded provided the park is free of trash and damage.

Permits for exclusive use of any pavilion will be an additional \$100, half of which will be refunded provided the pavilion is free of trash and damage.

Permit fees for use of any park or pavilion for fund-raisers, or by non-residents, shall be double the base fee.

All permit holders must have the permit in their possession at the time the facility is in use.


