

## **ATTENTION RESIDENTS**

On January 17, 2012 Municipal Council passed Ordinance 12-02 of 2012 which includes provisions that makes the below listed streets part of Parking Zone "C" as it relates to Section 305-52 C of the General Laws. This new regulation for your block will result in signs being posted on your block which will advise persons parking there that the street is zoned with a two-hour time limit. The times for the 2-hour limit are Monday – Saturday 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.

People who reside on these blocks may come to the police station at 235 East Airy Street Monday-Friday (8:30 AM – 4:30 PM) to receive a free zone parking permit which must be posted on the resident's vehicle(s). When coming for the permit you need to bring your driver's license and registration/insurance for the vehicle showing that the vehicle is registered to your address. If the vehicle is a work vehicle you will need a statement on company letterhead signed by a supervisor or owner indicating that you are permitted to use the vehicle for work purposes.

The permit will allow residents to disregard the zone time limits. There is a limit of three permits per household (single-family residency) and one for apartments. The permits are valid for zone exemption only and must be renewed annually. There are provisions for visitor permits and permits for persons performing work at your residence.

The law becomes effective January 22, 2012. The police department is allowing for a one-month grace period to allow residents the opportunity to come to the police station to receive their permits.
