RESOLUTION NO. 22-23 OF 2022

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NORRISTOWN, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED TRAFFIC CALMING POLICY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Norristown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania (the “Municipality”) is a Home Rule Municipality organized and operating in accordance with the Charter of the Municipality of Norristown (“Charter”) as permitted by the Home Rule Charter and Optional Plans Law, 53 Pa. C.S. 2901 et. seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 41.3-301 of the Charter grants to Municipal Council “All powers and duties of the Municipality, including those set forth in § 41.2-201 of this Charter and those in existence or hereafter conferred on the Municipality by the Constitution of Pennsylvania, or general law that includes the power to establish the policies, goals and objectives for the legislative, executive, administrative and advisory functions of the Municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, the Members of Council have received numerous requests from citizens to address both the volume and speed of traffic on the roads and streets of the Municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, a traffic calming policy establishing the procedure and process to consider and implement traffic calming measures has been prepared by the Public Works Department staff after consultation with the Police Department and is consistent with state and nationally accepted standards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Administrator has proposed that the Municipality adopt a Traffic Calming Policy to address that safety concerns of the citizens of the Municipality and the Members of Council and to provide the Municipality with various ways to make the streets, roads and alleys of the Municipality safer for pedestrians and vehicle operators and occupants.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Members of Council of the Municipality of Norristown, that Municipal Council hereby approves the Traffic Calming Policy as attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” and that the Municipal Administrator, or his designee, is authorized to take all action to effectuate the execution of this agreement and any related documents.
