THE PARADE ROUTE

The 2022 parade will follow the new route introduced in 2018, starting at St. Francis on Marshall Street and ending on Main Street. The estimated walk time for the parade is approximately 45 minutes, line up at 9:30 for step off time at 10:00 AM (Rain or Shine).

Each entry’s contact person must read, sign, and agree to abide by the following, and is responsible for insuring that the rest of the entry participants in their group understand and abide by the information below.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARADE PARTICIPANTS

- Do not throw water balloons, confetti, or any other large or hard objects during the parade.
- You may hand out candy or other small items, but they should be handed directly to parade watchers.
- All floats and other motorized vehicles are responsible for having liability insurance and must be able to provide documented proof of such on the day of the parade.
- All forms of profanity and derogatory wording is strictly forbidden, including but not limited to shirts, signs, banners, and all other forms of printed and non-printed materials.

In consideration of the acceptance of this application, the applicant agrees to abide the rules and regulations listed above as well as to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Municipality of Norristown, its employees, representatives and agents, from and against any and all liability, loss, cost, damage and expenses, including costs and attorney fees in defense thereof because of actions, claims, or lawsuits for damages resulting from personal or alleged to have been sustained by any person or persons and on account of damage to property, arising or alleged to have arisen directly or indirectly out of or in consequence of the applicant’s participation in any parade occurring with the Municipality of Norristown.
